As part of the YMCA's effort to help youth succeed, the Dallas YMCA offers, through the YMCA of Metropolitan Dallas Foundation, a scholarship program for graduating high school seniors with an affiliation to the Dallas YMCA living in the Dallas area.

Selections are based on college entrance scores, high school grades, financial circumstances, community service, and the individual's personal motivation and desire for furthering his/her education. Students have an opportunity to receive renewable scholarships up to \$3,000 per year for 4 years.

The postmark deadline is Saturday, January 25, 2014. Interview dates are Saturday, February 22nd and Saturday March 1st 2014 between 7:30 am to 12:00 pm.

## **GreenPal Business Scholarship**

The purpose of The GreenPal Small Business Scholarship is to assist a motivated, driven student and future business leader. We believe that the generation of today's students are the future employers of tomorrow. The future of our county will be forged by the entrepreneurial spirit of today's generation.

If you currently run a small business while attending college or have a small business idea to start while you plan to attend college, see below for the instructions and criteria for applying for the GreenPal scholarship.

1. **DEADLINE** for scholarship applications is **May 30th, 2014**.
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., evidence of GPA.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Submissions are to be submitted through the online application process below.
5. Scholarship winner will be announced June 15th, 2014.
6. This is an evergreen scholarship and will be renewed and funded each year by GreenPal.

**Award Components:**

Scholarship is \$2,000 paid equally over (4) semesters, this scholarship will be renewed each year with a new winner. Each winner will receive (4) awards of \$500 for each semester completed.

**Criteria:**

1. Applicant must be graduating High School's Senior Class in 2014 or currently enrolled in a college of business with a 3.0 or higher GPA
2. Applicant must demonstrate high ambition and desire to be an entrepreneur or business owner.
3. Applicant must have a declared major in the college of Business.
4. Funds must be used for full-time enrollment at accredited, nonprofit two or four-year colleges, Universities, vocational or technical schools in the United States.

## **UNCF Scholarship**

If you are a student attending a UNCF-member college or university, it is highly recommended that you also complete the UNCF general scholarship application. Once a student completes the application, the information will be used to match you to many of the specific programs administered by UNCF. The general application, however, does not apply to scholarship programs that require a separate application.

## **Tom Joyner Scholarship**

(DALLAS) The Tom Joyner Foundation® announced the 'Full Ride' scholarship program that will cover all the expenses of one student planning to attend a Historically Black College and University (HBCU) in the fall of 2014.

The winning student will receive full tuition and stipends for up to 10 semesters to cover on-campus room and board and books. Students must meet the required academic standards each semester to renew the funds each year. Graduating high school seniors can apply for the scholarship by going to the Tom Joyner Foundation website to download an application. (Click here to download the application). To be eligible, students must meet the following criteria:

A United States Citizen

Current high school seniors attending school in the United States (applicant must be anticipating completion of high school degree in the spring of 2014).

Minimum high school grade point average of 3.50 (on a 4.00 grade scale, excluding home school studies) and

Minimum SAT score of 2100 (combined math essay and verbal score) or ACT score of 30.

Applicants must apply and be accepted to an HBCU by July 1, 2014.

Applicants must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities.

The applications must be postmarked no later than January 17th, 2014. Interviews will occur in April 2014.

## **Delta Sigma Theta**

Each year the Dallas Alumnae Chapter awards a general four-year scholarship in honor of Frederica Chase Dodd, a National Founder, who was also a Dallas Alumnae charter member. The amount of the scholarship is \$10,000 paid in 4 year increments per semester. In addition, the chapter awards a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$500 in memory of our beloved chapter soror, Joy Woodfork.

To be eligible for the a scholarship, the student must:

\* be an African American female graduating in 2014

\* be in the upper 25% of her graduating class

\* demonstrate financial need

\* have good moral character and a record of service to the school or community

\* plan to attend a 4 year accredited college or university (applicants attending junior/community colleges will not be considered)

Applications will be available on January 9, 2014, and will be due on February 22, 2014. Applications will be distributed through area high schools and will also be available on this website.

### **Linda Lael Miller Scholarships for Women**

Linda Lael Miller Scholarships for Women is for women age 25 or older who want to complete their education. It is specifically designed to help women who were not able to complete their education previously due to barriers in their lives.

Eligible women must be 25 years old or older and planning to attend an accredited college or university in the U.S. or Canada. They must be U.S. or Canadian citizens. To apply, candidates must complete a 500-word essay that explains the reasons for applying for the scholarship, how the funds will be used, and how the scholarship award will help them with their education and career goals.

The scholarship is sponsored by author Linda Lael Miller, author of contemporary and historical stories that were on national bestsellers lists and won her numerous awards. Enduring her own struggles to become a writer, Linda established the scholarship to help other women succeed through education.

One winner per year will receive a scholarship award. Winners have included women from all walks of life who have struggled with obstacles that include disabilities, victims of domestic violence, single parents and older women, all of whom demonstrated a strong desire to pursue their dreams to complete their education.

The deadline for this scholarship is usually in AUGUST of each year, and the award amount is usually 1,000.
