EMBODI is a Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. national initiative to promote and provide collaborative efforts to improve the quality of life for targeted African American males ages 13-17 through a comprehensive approach aimed at developing their overall potential. It is symbolic of empowering African American males to immerse themselves in African and African American culture to see themselves as a person of great worth who can take his place with a life of meaning and accomplishment.

EMBODI works in tandem with Project MALE (Making Aspiring Leaders Excel), a collaborative effort of various organizations in Southern Dallas County united to create a success program for African-American males, primarily in the Kindergarten through 5th grade levels, or age 11. However, the Dallas Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority EMBODI program allows Project MALE to extend the program service to young males 14-17 year of age.
