Project MALE leaders have designed 2-3 hour monthly sessions connected to program objectives delivered through 5 content topics: Education, social/emotional development, history/cultural awareness, self-efficacy and management, and healthy lifestyles. Monthly sessions are held each 1st Saturday at Antioch Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church.

Project MALE 5th – 9th graders enrolled in the program go on to participate in the Delta EMBODI program upon completion.

Project MALE sessions include a college tour, a career fair, and financial literacy activities.
