- ◆ **Take responsibility for program property.**
 - ◇ Respect the building, grounds, and property.
 - ◇ Keep the campus free from trash and graffiti.

- ◆ **Support the learning process.**
 - ◇ Attend all classes regularly and on time.
 - ◇ Be prepared for class (i.e., bring assignments, books, and supplies).
 - ◇ Listen carefully to instructions.
 - ◇ Participate in class activities.
