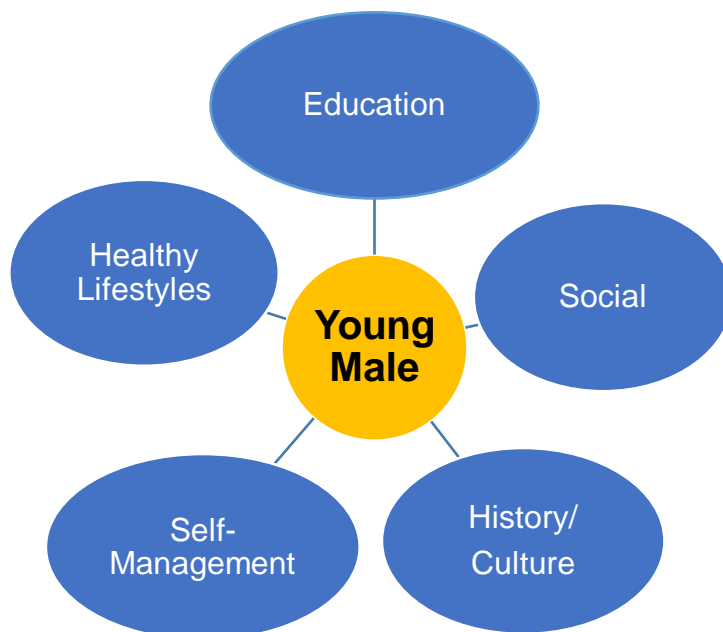
Project MALE--What It Is:
